About those kings...

Review: What was God's covenant with Adam? With Noah? With Abraham? With Moses?

1. God the King: Rejected (1 Samuel 8)
 - a. Why did the Israelites want a king instead of judges (vv.1-6)?
 - b. What did God say (vv.7-18)?
 - c. What did the Israelites do and what does this remind you of? (vv.19-22)

2. David the King: A Covenant (2 Samuel 7:1-17)
 - a. David is king after a long struggle with Saul, the first king. What does David want to do for God? (vv.1-3)
 - b. What does God say in response (vv.12-16)?
 - c. Who fulfilled this covenant with David and why should we care?

3. David the King: Failing (2 Samuel 11)
 - a. How was he in the wrong place (v.1)?
 - b. How was he doing the wrong thing (v.2)?
 - c. What made it worse (v.3-5)?
 - d. How did David try to cover his sin (vv.6-27)?

4. David the King: Repentance (Psalm 51)
 - a. What do we usually do when we're caught?
 - b. What does David do and why should we care?
