Why Study the Catechism?

From Luther's Preface to the Large Catechism:

- 1. **God's Instruction** "I cannot master the catechism as I wish. But I must remain a child and pupil of the catechism."
- 2. **God's Aid** "Catechism study is a most effective help against the devil, the world, the flesh, and all evil thoughts. It helps to be occupied with God's Word, to speak it, and to meditate on it."
- 3. God's Command "We should feel bound well enough by God's command alone."

"Can we finish learning in one hour what God Himself cannot finish teaching? He is engaged in teaching this from the beginning to the end of the world."
