## 2024 Pledge Card

The Bible teaches that giving is an act of thanks to God for His generosity and an act of faith that He will continue to provide. Please return this card to Christ the King by 12/3.

There are two possible ways to calculate your Financial Pledge:
(1) Percentage of Income - in the Old Testament, God taught His people to give one-tenth of their income to support the ministry of the priests and the care for the needy. This practice was continued (and even exceeded) in the New Testament church. To calculate a tithe is simple: take your annual income and remove the final digit (e.g. - $\$ 50,000$ income becomes a $\$ 5,000$ pledge).
(2) Percentage of Budget Need (helpful for those on a fixed income) - if all active families at Christ the King gave $\$ 3000 /$ year ( $\$ 250 /$ month), we would easily meet our budgeted expenses for 2024 . For comparison, this $\$ 3000$ pledge would be the equivalent of $10 \%$ tithing on a $\$ 30,000$ annual income.

To choose your Time and Talent Pledge, prayerfully consider those passions and skills that God has given you and indicate how you might use those to His glory and the growth of His Church.
