


Confession and Absolution


- \mathbf{P} In the name of the Father and of the + Son and of the Holy Spirit.

- **C** But if we confess our sins, God, who is faithful and just, will forgive our sins and cleanse us from all unrighteousness.


Silence for reflection on God's Word and for self-examination.

James 1:16-21







Apostles' Creed



Lord's Prayer


- Lord, remember us in Your kingdom and teach us to pray:








Post-Communion Collect


