Session Seven: Micah – The Truth About God’s Faithfulness

BACKGROUND

Who: Micah (“Who is like YHWH?”)

When: 750–686BC (Israel fell in 722; Isaiah... the two even share a message; Hosea)

Micah 1–3 (Doom)

Read 1:1–9: What event is prophesied and what is the general tone of the response?

Read 1:10–16: If you like puns...

Read 2:1–13: What should Judah’s response be? How are the people responding to Micah?

Read 3:1–12: If the people are in the wrong, who is truly to blame?

Read 4:1–5... Now read **Isaiah 2:2–4...** What is being envisioned here [twice]?

Read 4:6–13: Good news or bad news?

Micah 5:1–6: Who are we talking about here? (see Matthew 2:1–6)

Micah 5:7–15: What is the timeframe for this prophecy?

Micah 6–7 (Doom and Hope)

Read Micah 6:1–5: Presentation of the facts

Read Micah 6:6–8: What is truly desired?

Read Micah 6:9–16: Given the first and second portions of this courtroom drama, where does Judah stand

Read Micah 7:1–6: What not to trust in...

Read Micah 7:7: What to trust in...

Read Micah 7:8–10: What not to fear...

Read Micah 7:11–17: Why not (immediate)?

Read Micah 7:18–20: Why not (ultimate)?
